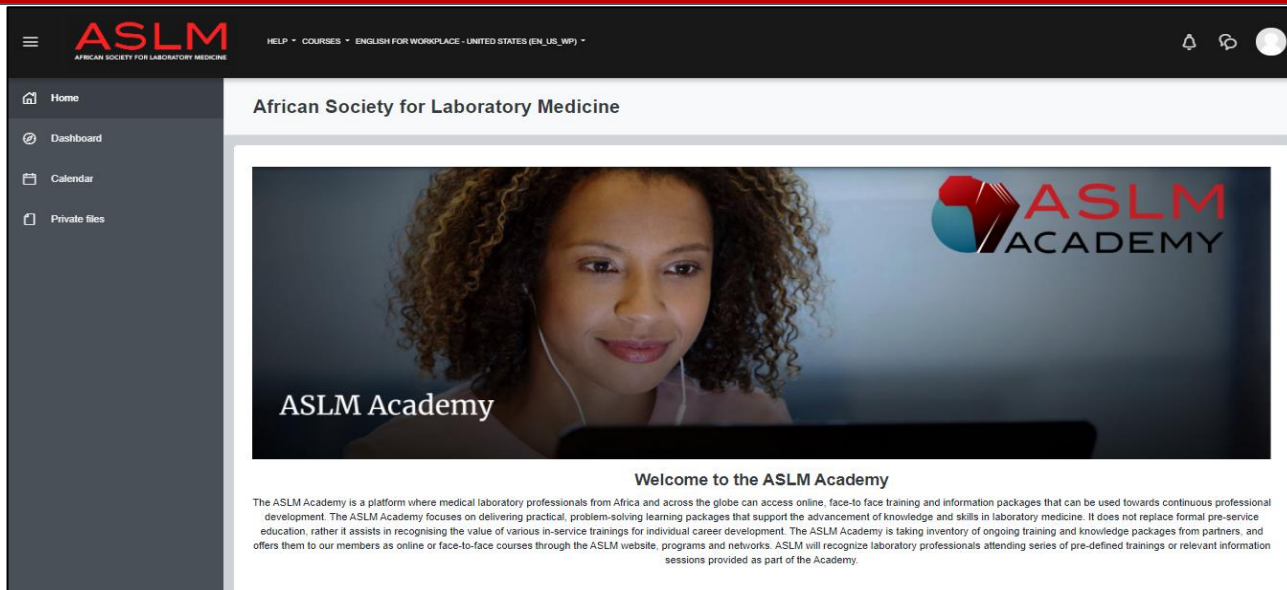

- Targets qualified HCWs (Lab and Non-Lab personnel)

Adaptable according to the in-country guidelines


GOAL

DIGITAL PLATFORM ACCESS AND CERTIFICATION

Open access to all

- Self enrollment. People can join with **intent for certification**, or just to review specific modules for **refresher training**.

Certification

- Those who intend to get certification **must complete all 11 modules, pass all knowledge checks** before they can get access to final assessment.
- **Pass mark to get certified ≥ 80%**
- Learners are allowed a window period of **2 days to 90 days** from enrollment date to finish the courses and obtain certification
- Certification is for **theory portion** of Ag-RDT training **ONLY**. Certified learners to complete in-country specific practical hands-on training

Refresher Training

- This is intended for learners who may need to refresh their knowledge
- Stakeholders interested in getting the training resource for scaleup of the training/capacity building
- No end of module quizzes, no final assessment
- Can start as refresher training but certification option remains available if all criteria is met
